 - Men's Half Marathon: Under 1hour 04minutes 00second / Men's 10000m: Under 29minutes 30second
 - Women's Half Marathon: Under 1hour 25minutes 00second / Women's 10000m: Under 37minutes 30second
11. Competition Rules The races will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the World Athletics, JAAF and the Race Organizer. As this race is an elite label recognized by the WA, the WA Road Race Label Regulations and the WA Advertising Regulations will be applied.
Doping control will also be conducted in accordance with the World Athletics Anti-Doping Regulations.
