10. Eligibility Athletes (Men and Women) who are 18 years old or older as of October 18, 2026, and who have a valid classification and meet the following requirements
*The record should be official recognized by WA(World Athletics), JAAF and WPA(World Para Athletics)
 - Wheelchair(Men and Women) : Under 1hour 15minutes 00second
 - Para Athletes(Except for Wheelchair/Men and Women) : Under 1hour 50minutes 00second
11. Eligible classes ①Visually impaired T11/T12, Upper-limb impaired T45/T46, Wheelchair T53/T54
② All other classes in the IPC categories
12. Competition Rules The races will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the WPA and WA or WPA Advertising Regulations.

Para Athletes with an International Classification Status of C or R are eligible for WPA Rankings and World Records/Asian Record (After FRD2026). The recognition of National record is also the same as above. However, the “international classifications” will be replaced as the “national classifications” for those who only have a national classification.
13. Field Size Around 30 Para Athletes (Mixed Race)
14. Entry Fee 13,200 JPY (Entry, handling fee and tax included)
*Payment process will be announced separately after the entry is completed.

* The entry fee for students such as university students, graduate students, and vocational school students will be half, 6,600 JPY (Entry, handling fee and tax included).

*T11/T12, T45/T46, and T53/T54 will each be awarded as a combined class.
* Only athletes who finish within 1 hour and 50 minutes will be eligible for awards.

*Prize money for placing and breaking the course record applies only to the following categories:
Visually Impaired T11/T12 (Men and Women),
Upper-Limb Impaired T45/T46 (Men)
Wheelchair T53/T54 (Men and Women)
*World and National Record bonuses apply to all classes with officially ratified records as of the event date.
For World and National Records in events requiring guides, half of the prize money will also be awarded to the guide runner. If two guides are involved, the half amount will be shared between them.
